Berry Metal joined at AISTech by U.S. Representatives Mike Kelly and Glenn Thompson.

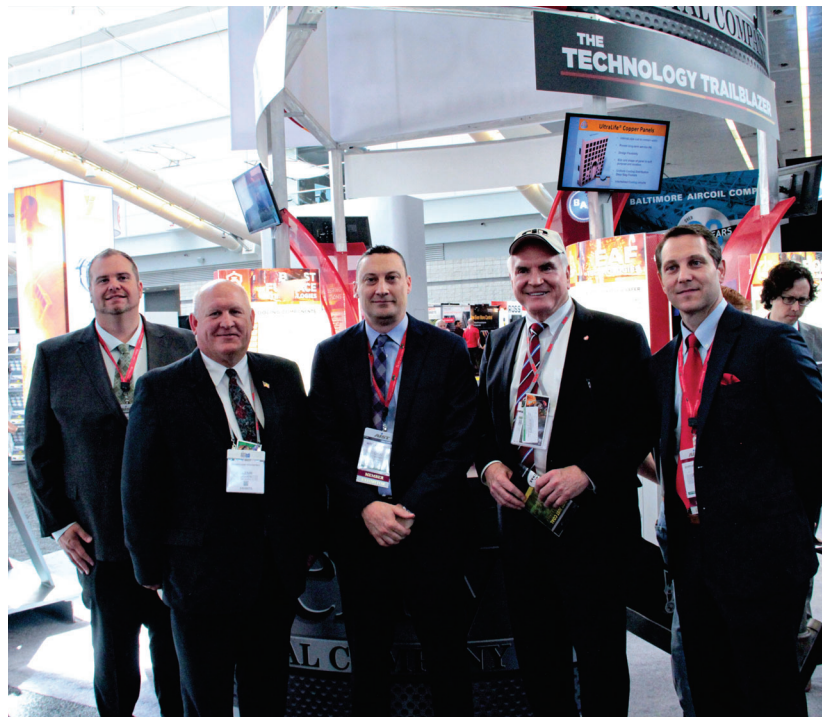
Berry Metal was out in force at the recent AISTech 2019 convention held in Pittsburgh, PA at the David L. Lawrence Convention Center on May 6-9.
